Since January 31st 2001 we have been advertising our attempts to deduce from 3 verses of the bible book of Revelation 17, the precise chronology of the rise to Power of the United Nations.

It is known by many that the bible is an accurate if somewhat unusual history book. It is known by many more that the New Testament is an enlightened moral guide for mankind, when sensibly interpreted. We believe that these 3 verses of Revelation contain the whole rise to power and authority to the class (Revetation 11/2). We understand this symbolism to be as follows: The Beast is the UN, the 8th King of the world. The 7 Previous kings over God's people are in order, the Egyptians, the Assyrians, the Babylonians, the Medo Persians, the Greeks, the Romans and the Anglo Americans.
